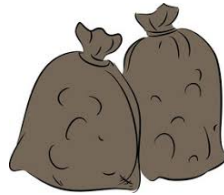

We look forward to this year's Christmas Holidays, and want to wish everyone a very safe and Merry Christmas and all the best in the New Year.

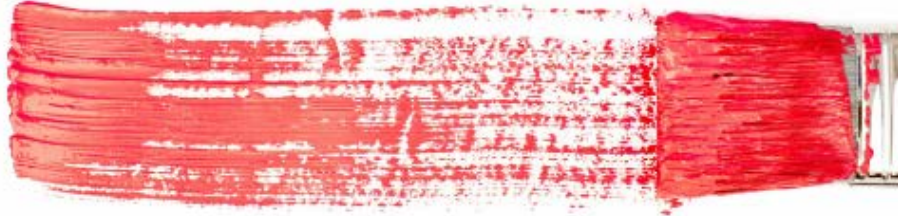
On behalf of the Kersley Parent Advisory Council, thanks again for all of your support.
